Camillus Health Concern, Inc. is an established leader in Miami since 1984 providing primary healthcare, mental health, and social services to men, women, and children who are poor or homeless. The organization is a ministry of the Hospitaller Order of St. John of God and a Federally Qualified Health Center with a medical staff trained to provide for the special health needs of our community's vulnerable and underserved populations. Camillus Health Concern, Inc. operates two sites in the Miami downtown area: the main site, Good Shepherd Health Center and a satellite clinic within the Camillus House Norwegian Cruise Line campus.



## ELIGIBILITY

- Income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Homeless, at-risk of homelessness, or uninsured

## WHAT TO BRING

- Personal Identification card, if you have one
- Proof of legal guardianship of your child
- Your child's birth certificate
- Health insurance information, if available
- Proof of household income
- Benefit(s) verification letter

- Payment is in accordance with a sliding fee scale
- Services provided regardless of ability to pay
